Brook House, 19 St. Georges Road

Located within a short and level walk of the centre of Truro and enjoying a leafy backdrop of Victoria Gardens, this charming and spacious townhouse retains a wealth of period features with classic Georgian proportions, an enclosed courtyard garden and accommodation over three floors.

Distances

Mainline railway station – 500 yards; Cathedral – 700 yards; Boscawen Park – 1.5; Idless Woods – 2; St Agnes – 9; Perranporth – 9; Mylor Yacht Harbour – 11; Falmouth – 12; Cornwall Airport (near Newquay) – 21

The Property

- A fine example of a late Georgian townhouse (circa 1860)
- Period detailing throughout including original cornicing, hallway corbel, high skirtings, sash windows and high ceilings
- Superb sitting room with open fireplace and original twin doors to the kitchen
- Kitchen / breakfast room with leafy outlook
- Utility room
- Two first floor double bedrooms
- Spacious family bathroom with separate WC
- Master bedroom occupying the entire top floor with en suite shower room

The Location

St George's Road is situated on the edge of the very centre of Truro and is known for its church and close proximity of the wonderful Victoria Gardens. Within the shortest of level walks are Truro's varied shops, cathedral, restaurants, museum, cinema and coffee shops. Idless Woods are just two miles away where there are wonderful woodland walks and cycle trails along with a popular open-air café.


Truro boasts a wide and varied mix of national and boutique retailers found within the pretty cobbled streets radiating out from its impressive and prominent cathedral.


